The NCDOT Division of Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation (DBPT) and the Transportation Planning Branch created in 2007 a regional bicycle planning program. To date, approximately \$2.5M has been allocated to 11 planning regions. At least parts of over 60 counties have been reached by completed or ongoing regional bike planning efforts. Development of the Fayetteville Area Regional Bike Plan would result in at least parts of 68 counties having a regional bike plan.

The State funding is part of DBPT's professional services budget. Board approval is requested for \$226,218 (State).

PROJECT SELECTION PROCESS

The regional bike planning program is structured to steadily fund planning regions across the State with the general goal to ensure that all counties in the State, assuming local support and interest, have some form of a regional bicycle plan. The regional bicycle planning program is currently funded to permit the development of one plan per year. With this in mind, DBPT desires to coordinate with one region in the State each year to develop a plan. Regions are selected through evaluation of local support and commitment and perceived regional and local need.

PROJECT / PROGRAM BENEFITS:

The plans permit the development and prioritization of projects, programs and policies that improve conditions for bicycling. These planning efforts are commonly utilized as an economic development/tourism tool in these regions through the creation of recreational mapping resources as well as the development of recommendations for various policies and programs that further enhance safe bicycling and encourage economic activity. The primary goals of this planning effort are to (a) identify an integrated bicycling system of primarily on-road, but also certain segments of off-road connectivity, that is safe and pleasant to use, (b) encourage regional coordination of bicycle improvements that enhance bicyclist access, mobility and safety, (c) promote policies and guidelines that assure the integration of bicycle accommodations in state, regional and local highway and bridge projects, (d) identify implementable priority project and program recommendations, and (e) contribute to local economic development in regions throughout the State.

RESULT OF PROJECT / PROGRAM NOT BEING FUNDED

Through the Regional Bicycle Planning Program, regional, county and local entities across the State are able to develop plans that help guide planning decisions for bicycle transportation and recreational needs. Locally adopted plans are requirements for infrastructure project submittal through the STI/Strategic Prioritization Process. The absence of regional bicycle plans may lead to inconsistent planning across local government boundaries and limited opportunity to submit bicycle improvements through the STI process.

North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Wake County This Interagency Agreement is to provide DEQ access to the Departments SAP System to provide support services for users and normal maintenance of the Department's SAP System. The Department and DEQ have agreed to up to one thousand and sixty (1060) SAP User Licenses within DEQ. DEQ shall provide payment for 100% of the cost of the work performed by the Department. The estimated amount for the requirements to implement the system is \$161,000. DEQ shall also reimburse the Department actual support costs up to a maximum of \$25,000 annually.

Division 1

North Carolina & Virginia Railroad Company, LLC, dba Chesapeake & Albemarle (NCVA dba CA) Norfolk Southern Railway Company, Inc. (NS) Camden, Currituck, and Pasquotank Counties 80000.1.4.32 This Rail Agreement covers the approval of Freight Rail & Rail Crossing Safety Improvement (FRRCSI) funds to assist NCVA dba CA with replacement of culverts, crossties, surfacing, bridge repairs, and other improvements. The work will be performed at various mileposts along the NS corridor in Camden, Currituck, and Pasquotank Counties. NCVA dba CA will perform the work. The Department will participate in the project to the extent of 50% or up to \$362,500, whichever is less of the total estimated cost of the project. As a condition of the award of funds, NS and the Department shall enter into a Contingent Interest Agreement and Instrument of Indebtedness to secure a lien on the project assets for five (5) years.

County of Dare EB-5542 55062.1.3

This Project consists of a Planning Study of an off-the road paved pathway along 7.6 miles of NC 12 Highway in the two historic unincorporated villages of Frisco and Buxton. The total estimated project cost is \$105,000. The Department shall participate in 80% of the total cost through STPEB funds, up to a maximum amount of Eighty Four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000). The Municipality shall provide a 20% (\$21,000) local match of the total cost.

Division 5

Town of Cary Wake County U-5315 45429.1.1 This Project consists of the relocation and adjustment of Town of Cary owned water lines for Project U-5315. At the request of the Municipality, the Department shall adjust and/or relocate municipally-owned water lines. The Municipality shall reimburse the Department the entire cost of said utility work. The estimated reimbursement is \$1,072,829.

This Supplemental Agreement is to provide additional funding for the Project. The Department's original participation was \$174,900 in STP-DA Funds. The Department agrees to reimburse the Municipality an additional \$62,375 of Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds. The Municipality's original participation was \$112,100. The Municipality will provide an additional \$62,375 as their local match and all costs that exceed the total estimated cost.

City of Durham Durham County U-5968 45982.1.1 45982.2.1 45982.3.1 This Project consists of the modernization, rehabilitation, and expansion of the existing computerized traffic signal system in Durham. The Department is responsible for all phases of the Project. The total estimated cost is \$22,613,750, based on 387 signals at a cost of \$58,433 each. The Department will participate in the costs up to \$22,346,593. The Municipality will pay the Department \$674,158 upon completion of the Project.

Town of Apex Wake County U-5530AC 44111.3.19 This Project consists of completing a pedestrian route from south of James Street to downtown Apex along the Town's historic main street. The Municipality is responsible for all phases of the Project. The Department shall reimburse 70% (\$399,000) of approved eligible costs from TAP funds and the Municipality will be responsible for providing the 30% (\$171,000) non-federal match and all costs that exceed the total available funding.

Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) Wake County This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) establishes the terms and conditions for installing, monitoring, and maintaining counter equipment station locations in the municipalities of Apex, Cary, Raleigh and Wake Forest. The Agency shall be responsible for administering all work and the Department will provide technical oversight.

Division 6 & 8

Aberdeen and Rockfish Railroad Company (AR) Cumberland & Hoke Counties 80000.1.4.15 This item supersedes the agenda item that was approved at the January 8, 2015 Board of Transportation meeting. This Rail Supplemental Agreement reflects a modification in the scope of the work, without any change to the Department's participation of up to \$380,452. The initial scope consisted of the upgrading of 4.6 miles of rails, and the addition of ballast and surface for 5 miles. The modified scope consists of the upgrading of 1 mile of track, track repair for 1.39 miles, and ballast and surfacing for 6.8 miles. All other provisions of the Agreement will remain the same.

At the request of the Municipality, the Department shall include provisions in the construction contract for the contractor to adjust and relocate municipally-owned water lines. The Municipality shall reimburse the Department the entire cost of said utility work. The estimated reimbursement from the Municipality is \$39,325.

City of Sanford Lee County EB-5542 55062.1.3 This Project consists of a Planning Study establishing Carthage Street/Charlotte Avenue from 11th Street to Wicker Street as an east-west urban boulevard that incorporates both bike and pedestrian improvements. The total estimated project cost is \$105,000. The Department shall participate in 80% of the total cost through STPEB funds, up to a maximum amount of Eighty Four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000). The Municipality shall provide a 20% (\$21,000) local match of the total cost.

City of Siler City Chatham County EB-5542 55062.1.3 This Project consists of a Planning Study to extend sidewalk north along one side of North Chatham Avenue (SR 1108) from Craven Street to the northern city limit boundary. The total estimated project cost is \$105,000. The Department shall participate in 80% of the total cost through STPEB funds, up to a maximum amount of Eighty Four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000). The Municipality shall provide a 20% (\$21,000) local match of the total cost.

Division 9

Town of China Grove Rowan County I-3802B 36780.3.GV2 This Design-Build Project consists of adding additional lanes on I-85 from Lane Street (Exit 63) to US 29-601 Connector (Exit 68) in Rowan County, including provisions in the construction contract for the construction of sidewalk on Main Street in China Grove. The Municipality will participate in the cost with a lump sum payment of \$18,526.64 upon completion of the sidewalk.

CSX Transportation, Inc.(CSXT) Union County P-5704 46398.1.1 46398.3.1 On October 2, 2009, the Department and CSXT entered into a Railroad Master Construction Agreement which detailed the terms and conditions by which CSXT would construct various rail safety improvements within the State of North Carolina. This Addendum #10 to the Master Construction Agreement covers the construction of approximately a 2 mile passing siding track in Indian Trail from east of Wesley Chapel Stouts Road near milepost SF-32.8 to east of Indian Trail Road near milepost SF-314.5. The Department shall perform the design work and obtain the permits, under the terms of the Preliminary Engineering Agreement. CSXT shall perform all of the construction work for the project within the existing right-of-way. The Department shall reimburse CSXT 50% of the actual eligible costs. City of Charlotte Mecklenburg County P-5705B, 44475.1.2 This Rail Framework Agreement covers general intent and responsibilities of the Parties in regard to the construction and maintenance of all work associated with the Charlotte Gateway Station (CGS). This Agreement sets out a scope of work for CGS track, structures, signal infrastructure, a temporary and/or permanent passenger station, and the demolition of the platform and access facilities in the railroad right of way at the existing Amtrak station on N. Tryon Street. The Agreement does not include any funding or reimbursement for the CGS.

On May 26, 2015, the Department and the Municipality entered into a Rail Municipal Agreement, which was supplemented on October 18, 2016, for the advancement of property acquisition and construction of a multimodal transportation facility, known as the Charlotte Gateway Station. This Municipal Agreement supersedes the previously executed agreements and covers funding sources, general intent, and responsibilities of the Parties in regard to the construction and maintenance of all work associated with the Charlotte Gateway Station (CGS). The Agreement defines multiple phases of project work, including track, structures and signals (Phase 1a); platform, canopy and supporting improvements (Phase 1b); and the station construction (Phase 2). The Agreement allocates responsibilities for all project work across phases. The estimated total project cost is \$ 133,200,000.00. The Municipality secured \$15,000,000 in FHWA STP-DA funds and a USDOT TIGER VII grant for \$30,000,000. NCDOT secured a USDOT TIGER VI Grant for \$200,000. The Municipality will contribute up to \$33,000,000 and the estimated cost to the Department is up to \$55,000,000.

City of Charlotte Mecklenburg County U-5905 46450.1.1 46450.2.1 46450.3.1 This Project consists of improvements along Lakeview Road (SR 2112) from Old Statesville Road (NC 115) to Reames Road (SR 2110) for the purpose of increasing vehicular capacity at key intersections along the corridor and to provide multimodal facilities where possible to facilitate movement to Lakeview Direct Connect Interchange. The Municipality is responsible for all phases of the Project. This Supplemental Agreement is for the Department to reimburse the Municipality for the ROW and Utility phases of the Project with no change in funding. The Department will participate in project costs up to the maximum amount of \$9,000,000.

Town of Indian Trail Union County U-5987 45966.2.1 45966.3.1 This Project consists of geometric changes and the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Unionville-Indian Trail Road West and Sardis Church Road. The Municipality shall reimburse the Department the entire cost of said utility work. The estimated reimbursement from the Municipality is \$394,000.

The Department shall prepare the environmental and/or planning document, Project plans and specifications, construct the Project, and acquire any needed right of way. The Municipality is responsible for all phases of the Project. This Supplemental Agreement is to increase funding. The Department shall participate in an additional amount not to exceed \$750,000 (48%) in STBGDA funds. The Municipality will be responsible for providing \$816,756 (52%) as the nonfederal match.

City of Gastonia Gaston County C-5622 46399.3.F1 This Project consists of construction of a ten-foot wide greenway trail from US 321 to Bulb Avenue to connect with the Highland Rail Trail. This Supplemental Agreement is to increase funding. The Department shall participate in an additional amount not to exceed \$100,000 (80%) in CMAQ funds. The Municipality will be responsible for providing \$25,000 (20%) as their local match.

Town of Mount Holly Gaston County C-5606A 43728.1.1 43728.2.1 43728.3.1 This Project consists of construction of sidewalk along Belmont-Mount Holly Road between existing sidewalks at the Circle K gas station near Belmont Abbey College to the existing sidewalk at Margarette Avenue. The Department shall reimburse 79% of approved eligible costs from the CMAQ funds allocation, not to exceed \$312,352. The Municipality will be responsible for providing the 21% (\$80,030) non-federal match for the CMAQ funds authorized and all costs that exceed the total available funding.

City of Hickory Catawba County EB-5808 46463.1.1 46463.3.1 This Project consists of upgrading current pedestrian signals with LED countdown signal heads and audible push buttons and installing pedestrian signals and audible push buttons at select City-owned signals that do not have them currently. The Department shall reimburse 80% of approved eligible costs from the STBGDA funds allocation, not to exceed \$322,000. The Municipality will be responsible for providing the 20% (\$80,500) non-federal match and all costs that exceed the total available funding.




60 Month Revenue & Expenditure Projections as of February 2017



NCDOT Revenue Sources SFY2017 - \$4.7 Billion




Uses of 2016-17 NCDOT Appropriations Total Funding = \$4.7 Billion













Prioritization 4.0 and Draft 2018-2027 STIP










