Wednesday, May 1, 2019

Call to Order

Chairman Fox called the meeting of the Board of Transportation to order at 6:25 p.m. on Wednesday, May 1, 2019, at the US Army Airborne & Special Operations Museum in Fayetteville, North Carolina with the following members present: Fox, Moran, Overholt, Alford, Tulloss, Jordan, Hunt, Molamphy, Bowles, Tarleton, Perkins, Pope, Lathrop, Debnam, and Zimmer.

Vice Chair Szlosberg-Landis, Board Member Taft, Board Member Wells, and Board Member Clarke were absent.

Chairman Fox Remarks

Chairman Fox welcomed all the guests. Chairman Fox acknowledged Major General Deedrick, Colonel Reed, Mayor Colvin and City Manager Doug Hewett for taking time to attend the special event at the US Army Airborne and Special Operations Museum this evening.

Chairman Fox noted that a quorum was met based on board member attendance and proceeded to the ethics statement.

Ethics Statement

Chairman Fox read the Ethics Statement advising all members of the Board that may have any conflict of interest or appearance of conflict to abstain from participation in that particular item and to file the proper paperwork with the Secretary to the Board of Transportation.

Road, Bridge and Ferry Naming Honorary Designations

Airborne & Special Operations Highway Designation Overlay and Extension

Chairman Fox stated the Board of Transportation will consider the Airborne & Special Operations Highway overlay designation for the entire portion of I-295, in both present and future extensions from I-95 to I-95.

Chairman Fox invited Board Member Grady Hunt to read the resolution for the Airborne &Special Operations Highway. A motion was made by Board Member Hunt and seconded by Board Member Overholt. Members of the Board of Transportation unanimously approved the Airborne & Special Operations Highway Designation. (A copy of the resolution is at the end of this document).

Vice Chair Szlosberg-Landis, Board Member Taft and Board Member Wells called in to the meeting.

Board Member Clarke was absent.

Ethics Statement

Chairman Fox read the Ethics Statement advising all members of the Board that may have any conflict of interest or appearance of conflict to abstain from participation in that particular item and to file the proper paperwork with the Secretary to the Board of Transportation.

Chairman Fox Remarks

Chairman Fox welcomed all the guests. Chairman Fox acknowledged Board Member Grady Hunt and Division Six Engineer Greg Burns for their hard work and diligence putting together a wonderful trip. Chairman Fox recognized Campbell University for the tour of their campus and demonstrating construction and transportation projects the Department has been involved with currently and in past years. Chairman Fox discussed the importance of Fort Bragg and the opportunity extended for members to participate in a comprehensive tour. He thanked Colonel Reed, garrison commander of Fort Bragg for his hospitality and time.

<u>ACTION</u>

Approval – April 4, 2019 Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Fox stated that the meeting minutes were distributed for review prior to the meeting. Chairman Fox asked for a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the April 4, 2019 Board of Transportation meeting. A motion was made by Board Member Tarleton and seconded by Board Member Perkins. Members of the Board of Transportation unanimously approved the meeting minutes as provided.

Road, Bridge and Ferry Naming Honorary Designations

Resolution for The Airborne and Special Operations Highway

Chairman Fox announced he would use Chairman's discretion regrading moving "Item O" up on the agenda. Chairman Fox invited the Colonel Reed, garrison commander of Fort Bragg and his staff along with Board Member Grady Hunt and Division Six Engineer Greg Burns forward to participate in signing the agreement before them. Chairman Fox provided a brief overview of the Intergovernmental Agreement and Memorandum of Agreement between the Fort Bragg and the Department. He shared that the agreement provides assistance to Range Road and other selected interior roads on the base where roads are shared with the citizens of Fayetteville. Additionally, members of the Board were provided information pertaining to the agreement during their session at Fort Bragg the previous day.

A motion was made by Board Member Perkins and seconded by Board Member Debnam. Members of the Board of Transportation unanimously approved all project items in Item O, the Municipal and Special Agreement section as presented in the board's meeting materials.

Road Gang Award

Chairman Fox invited former Board Member Terry Hutchens from Division Six forward to receive the Road Gang Award for his service to the board. Chairman Fox read the Road Gang Award to Mr. Hutchens and thanked him for his service, influence and achievements pertaining to local transportation projects. Mr. Hutchens made brief, gracious remarks to the board and thanked everyone for the award.

Resolution for Mac Campbell Jr. Highway

Board Member Hunt presented a resolution for the naming of the NC-87 Bypass in Bladen County as the Mac Campbell Jr Highway. The resolution was unanimously approved by the Board upon a motion by Board Member Hunt and seconded by Board Member Tulloss. (A copy of the resolution is at the end of this document).

Resolution for Lyndo Tippett Highway

Board Member Tulloss presented a resolution in naming a section of I-295 within Cumberland County as the Lyndo Tippett Highway. The resolution was unanimously approved by the Board upon a motion by Board Member Tulloss and seconded by Board Member Perkins. (A copy of the resolution is at the end of this document).

*Please note the Board is expected to vote on the specific sections of road related to the Tippett and Campbell namings during their June 6, 2019 meeting. The Mac Campbell Jr. Highway section is proposed to be the NC-87 Bypass from NC-41 to NC-87 in Bladen County and the Lyndo Tippett Highway is proposed to be I-295 from I-95 to US-401.

Secretary's Remarks

Chairman Fox spoke on behalf of Secretary Trogdon.

CCX Carolina Connector

On behalf of Secretary Trogdon, Chairman Fox acknowledged the success on the groundbreaking of the Carolina Connector project in Edgecombe County. Chairman Fox mentioned the Department is working to build a transportation system for people and goods to move from one place to another seamlessly. The Carolina Connector provides the missing link in the freight logistics network and projects like this are part of the viral network that will keep our state economically competitive. He thanked the great team effort between Governor Cooper, the NC Department of Transportation, CSX, and the Carolinas Gateway Partnership.

North Carolina First Commission

Chairman Fox explained to keep the competitive edge in transportation Secretary Trogdon created the N.C. First Commission in March of this year. The commission will evaluate the state's current and future transportation investment needs and advise on better ways to ensure financial resources are available in the future. Fourteen experts in business, finance, and public policy from across North Carolina were selected to be a part of the commission.

Infrastructure Investments – Ports & Bridge

On behalf of Secretary Trogdon Chairman Fox acknowledged North Carolina's third neo-Panamax crane arrived at the Port of Wilmington after traveling from China. Chairman Fox stated the crane enables the port to operate ships carrying 14,000 twenty foot equivalent (TEU) containers; the largest ships operating on the East Coast. Chairman Fox mentioned strategic investments were also made in Charlotte with the opening of the Sugar Creek Road Bridge. Sugar Creek is the busiest railroad crossing in the state, with more than forty Norfolk Southern freight trains and another ten passenger trains each day. Chairman Fox stated the bridge will improve the safety and keep traffic and trains moving efficiently in that area.

Safety – Record Breaking Number of Bike Helmets Distributed

Chairman Fox shared that safety is the Department's number one priority and as part of the safety initiative, the Department gave away bike helmets to a record number of children in April. Chairman Fox mentioned over three thousand kids received lifesaving bicycle helmets. Chairman Fox acknowledged the Bicycle Helmet Initiative has proven to reduce bicycle injuries and fatalities by nearly 90 percent.

National Drone Award

Chairman Fox acknowledged the Division of Aviation for traveling to Chicago to the Unmanned Vehicle Systems Internationals annual XPONENTIAL conference. Chairman Fox recognized the Division of Aviation was awarded AUVSI's XCELLENCE award in the humanitarian category for its groundbreaking use of drones during the response in Hurricane Florence. Chairman Fox stated the Division of Aviation was able to help the Department and other state agencies in making decisions around aiding emergency responses, planning detour routes, assessing future repair needs, and warning the public of the dangers on the roads.

Global TransPark – John Rouse Named Interim Director

Chairman Fox called on John Rouse the Eastern Chief Deputy engineer, who has agreed to serve as the interim executive director for the Global TransPark. Chairman Fox stated John will replace Allen Thomas who resigned in March of this year to run for the late Walter Jones seat in Congress. Chairman Fox shared that John Rouse is a Lenoir County native that has spent more than 28 years working as a transportation engineer. John is intimately familiar with the transportation and economic development issues that are important down east. Chairman Fox welcomes John Rouse again as the interim executive director for the Global TransPark.

DELEGATED AUTHORITY ITEMS

Approval – Award of Highway Construction Contracts in April 2019 Letting

Chairman Fox stated that items C, D, E, H, and L are delegated to the Secretary and require no formal action by the Board. He shared that for Item C: action is being delayed on one project to allow additional time for internal review and all remaining projects were awarded by the Secretary to the low bidder.

Approval of Projects

A motion was made by Board Member Overholt and seconded by Board Member Alford to approve all projects for items G, I (I-1A, I-2, I-3, I-4), K, M, N, O, P, R and T (excluding items C, D, E, H, and L as they are delegated authority items and require no formal board action).

Board Member Zimmer abstained from voting on all projects for items:

 Initial funds are requested for preliminary engineering.

The existing system has exceeded the normal life expectancy of the equipment. This is a State Aid to Airports project with the local match provided via the Local Safety Enhancement Program. [PR# 4053] *Requesting Cash Flow of \$291,600 Fiscal Year 2020 Funds.

- Item M-13 Project R-5790; 44920.1.1, TAP-000S (892): Various Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Projects in Highway Division 10. \$150,000.00 has previously been approved for preliminary engineering. Additional funds are needed as requested.
- Item O Deere & Company; John Deere Turf Care, Wake County, 36249.4009: This Project consists of installation of a new traffic signal at the plant entrance on NC 55, just south of SR 2765 (Old Honeycutt Road). The Department will review the traffic signal plans and inspect the traffic signal installation. The Developer shall reimburse the Department 100% for the work. PRODUCT HIGHLIGHT – Preformed Thermoplastic Markings

Thermoplastic pavement marking is a type of pavement marking material used on roads that is typically composed of plastic, pigments, packing materials and glass beads to provide thick, durable, and reflective roadway markings. When placed on the roadway surface, the markings are not flush with the surface, which makes them susceptible to snow plows. Therefore, this type of material is most often used in warmer climates. Thermoplastic paint is originally produced as a powder. For road applications, it is heated to approximately 400 °F causing it to liquify and allowing the material to be applied to the pavement surface. This is often accomplished using a hand-pushed cart (shown in the image to the right). This cart can also be used to apply characters such as arrows and words.

Recently, a secondary option for placing thermoplastic has become available. Thermoplastic lines and characters are being pre-made – known as preformed thermoplastic markings. These preformed markings can be placed by hand and then bonded to the pavement using a handheld torch. These premade materials are convenient for maintenance operations by avoiding the added equipment. These preformed markings are ready for traffic after approximately 15 minutes. There are currently three preformed thermoplastic marking products approved on the Approved Products List and have been used recently on US 64 in Knightdale.

PRODUCT INNOVATION – Durisol Precast Noise Barrier

Noise barriers are placed adjacent to highways to reduce traffic noise for nearby communities in locations that warrant one after a noise study. In North Carolina, noise barriers are typically made of concrete and reflect noise away from the protected area. In certain situations, it is more beneficial to have barriers that absorb the sound rather than reflect. These situations include locations where barriers run parallel on both sides of the highway, or if there is a reflective retaining wall on the opposing side. Absorptive barriers are successful by being porous at the surface and made up of a sound-dampening material.

Durisol's Precast Noise Barrier, manufactured in Canada and Virginia, is an absorptive noise barrier that uses shredded wood chips mixed with Portland cement to create the desired porous sound-dampening properties. This lightweight barrier is created in three layers, with the outside layers composed of Portland cement and wood chip blend. The inside layer has concrete and steel reinforcement bars providing necessary structural strength. Durisol's Precast Noise Barrier can be cast with various designs and be stained to match the Department's desired aesthetic look. It is currently Accepted for Field Trial Use on the Approved Products List with the product number NP18-8093 and is expected to be placed and evaluated on project I-5111 along I-40 in Wake and Johnston Counties.
