Department of Transportation Cash Balance Report

Pursuant to Session Law, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is required to report its cash balance when in excess of one billion dollars at the end of each month. As of November 30, 2017, the balance is \$1.9 billion, which is 134 days of working capital.

The balance exceeded \$1 billion due to:

- State revenues exceeded the forecast through October 2017
- Construction expenditures were less than forecasted as of October 2017

NCDOT has contractual obligations of \$4.9 billion of which outstanding purchase orders amount to \$297 million and outstanding contracts amount to \$4.6 billion.

The Department's project expedited delivery efforts this year have accelerated over 350 and added nearly 150 new projects to the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Over \$2 billion in project lettings are scheduled for award in SFY 2018. As of October 2017, \$275 million have been awarded.
