Cash Balance Report Pursuant to Session Law 2014-100 §34.23(c)

As of April 30, 2018, the combined end of month closing cash balance of the Highway Fund and the Highway Trust Fund was \$1.6 billion, which is 119 days of working capital. The Department has contractual obligations of \$5.4 billion: outstanding purchase orders of \$335 million and outstanding contracts of \$5.1 billion.

The daily cash balance during March fluctuated between \$1.6 and \$1.8 billion.

Cash balances are projected to continue to fall as a result of the Department's project delivery efforts. Our commitment to expediting projects is reflected in our 2018-2027 STIP. Of the roughly 1,400 projects in the STIP, 500 are being accelerated, and of these 500, 150 are new projects with a value of \$5.3 billion. As of March 2018, \$1,324 million of these STIP projects have been awarded.

Through March 2018, project delivery indicators have increased over the same period last year. Construction and maintenance lettings increased 62% over the same period last year. Preliminary engineering lettings increased 141%. All highway expenditure indicators increased year over year. The Department's progress in delivering projects has contributed to a March 2018 cash balance that is \$274 million lower than the cash balance level in March 2017.
