Youth, Motorcycle & Bicycle Safety Campaigns

May is National Youth Traffic Safety Month, Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month and National Bicycle Safety Month.

New Clayton Route Opens

CLAYTON – The newly constructed extension of Ranch Road to Clayton Boulevard (formerly U.S. 70 Business) opened for the first time April 21.



The \$9.7 million construction

project is expected to alleviate congestion in this fast-growing area of Johnston County by creating a new commuter route to Interstate 42.

Under the project, Ranch Road was extended to Rose Street, which was a dead end at the busy intersection of Clayton Boulevard and N.C. 42 East in Clayton. In addition, Little Creek Church Road was realigned with Ranch Road where a traffic signal was installed and activated April 21.

Bridge in Edgecombe County Being Replaced

TARBORO – A project to replace a bridge on Thigpen Road in Edgecombe County near the Pitt County line is scheduled to begin last month.

A state highway contractor has closed the road as it crosses Mitchell Swamp Canal to remove a 60 -year-old bridge that has a timber driving deck and wooden barrier rails, or walls. The bridge was nearing the end of its useful service life.
