Youth, Motorcycle & Bicycle Safety Campaigns

May is National Youth Traffic Safety Month, Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month and National Bicycle Safety Month.

In North Carolina, motorcycles make up just 2% of registered vehicles but account for nearly 10% of road fatalities. Proper training, wearing helmets, and following traffic laws greatly reduce the risk of crashes.

Drivers should stay alert, watch for motorcycles and bicycles, and always share the road.

NCDOT offers a variety of <u>safety resources</u> to help protect all users of the statemaintained road system.

News Near You

The N.C. Department of Transportation has awarded a \$2.3 million contract to Sunrock Industries LLC to improve more than 16 miles of roadway in Franklin County.

The project will include milling, resurfacing and shoulder reconstruction. The roads to be improved are:

- Brantleytown Road/Old Halifax Road from the Franklin-Wake County line to N.C. 39
- Halifax Road from North Bickett Boulevard to Justice Street
- Vaiden Road from Schloss Road to N.C. 58
- 11 stretches of secondary roadway

Work may begin this spring and is expected to be completed by late fall 2026.
